



Art in Central Park - Guidelines for Artists

This new promotion for 2019 has been created to showcase the artistic talent on the Two Rivers area with 20 creations of local artists being printed on vinyl banners to be displayed in the east side of Central Park in downtown Two Rivers from May through October.

1. Design will be created on a 12”w x 24”h canvas supplied by Two Rivers Main Street
 - a. Available at Two Rivers Main Street office or Basil Ishkabibble’s Art Gallery
2. Artists will receive recognition on the Two Rivers Main Street website and social media pages, as well as in the print brochure for the event.
3. Participation cost for artist is \$25.00 (student cost \$5.00). This is to be paid when you pick up your canvas.
4. The deadline to turn in your canvas is Monday, April 19th. The selected art works will be displayed at an opening party to be held at Basil Ishkabibble’s Art Gallery in early May. The canvasses will be auctioned off at this event.
5. We ask that the art not depict anything political. As the art will be displayed in a city park, art should be appropriately family-friendly.
6. All proceeds from 2019 Art in the Park will be used to replace the planters displayed on Washington Street.
