

Downtown Banner Art Program - Guidelines for Artists

The banner art display is back for 2022. This year, banners will be displayed at the intersections on Washington Street. This will give us the opportunity to display 28 creations of local artists being printed on vinyl banners in downtown Two Rivers from May through October.

- 1. Design will be created on a 12"w x 24"h canvas supplied by Two Rivers Main Street. Canvasses are available at Seeds N' Beans and the Two Rivers Main Street office. If you prefer a different medium, please follow the above dimensions. Digital art is welcomed.
- 2. Artists will receive recognition on the Two Rivers Main Street website and social media pages, as well as in an art walk page on our smartphone app.
- 3. Participation cost for artists is \$5.00 (students are fre2). This is to be paid when you pick up your canvas.
- 4. The deadline to turn in your canvas is Monday, May 9th. The selected art works will be displayed at the Two Rivers Main Street office. They will stay on display until the banners are installed.
- 5. We ask that the art not depict anything political. As the art will be displayed in a public area, art should be appropriately family-friendly.
- 6. All proceeds from 2022 Art in the Park will be used for future beautification projects in downtown Two Rivers.
